### What tests do I have to pass to graduate? Current 12<sup>th</sup> grade students

#### FSA English Language Arts Test (taken in 10<sup>th</sup> grade)

- Earning an achievement level of 3 or higher on the FSA retake (in fall and spring)
- Earn a score of 19 on the ACT Reading subtest
- Earn a score of 24 on the SAT Reading test
- Earn a score of 430 on the SAT Evidence-Based Reading and Writing.

#### Algebra 1 EOC Test

- Earn an achievement score of 3 or higher on the ALG 1 EOC retake (given in the fall and spring)
- Earn a 16 on the ACT Math subtest
- Earn a score of 420 on the SAT Math
- Earn a score of 430 on the PSAT Math section.

#### Current 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students:

- Earning an achievement level of 3 or higher on the FSA retake (in fall and spring)
- Earn a score of 18 on the ACT English and Reading subtest
- Earn a score of 480 on the SAT Evidence-Based Reading and Writing.

#### Algebra 1 EOC Test

- Earn an achievement score of 3 or higher on the ALG 1 EOC retake (given in the fall/ spring)
- Earn a 16 on the ACT Math subtest
- Earn a score of 420 on the SAT Math
- Earn a score of 430 on the PSAT Math section.
