- 1. An overall weighted GPA of 3.0 or higher
- 2. Recommended PSAT Total Score of 950 higher--if taken
- 3. Completion of the pre-IB/AP program is highly recommended but not required
- 4. Completion of 3 years of the same foreign language by the start of 11th grade (recommended but not required)
- 5. Completion of Algebra II (recommended but not required)
- 6. 9th Grade FSA ELA and the Algebra I EOC—both with a score of 3 or higher

Students not meeting these requirements can still apply. Their application will be reviewed by a committee to determine placement.

Teacher Recommendations will be obtained by Mr. Sturgeon if necessary.
