Participation in the graduation ceremony is a privilege.
Please be reminded to follow all rules and guidelines you have been given up to and during your graduation ceremony.

Senior Exams

All seniors are required by SDIRC Pupil Progression Plan to take exams. Exams count for 20% of each course's semester average. Senior Exams are scheduled for May 9th & 10th. Seniors will take periods 1,2,5,7 on May 9th and 2,4,5,6 on May 10th. Anyone scheduled for IB or AP Exams on May 9th & 10th will need to arrange a make-up day for any course exams that will be missed.

ALS Course Recovery

The N-205 lab will be open the week of May 13, although seniors are encouraged NOT to wait until the last minute.

Obligations

Graduates must take care of all obligations before you can walk at graduation. This includes all textbooks, fees, uniforms, cafeteria balances, library books and fees.

Each graduate receives 2 tickets for this event. You will receive these tickets along with your graduation tickets. This is a fun evening recognizing you and your fellow classmates. Many awards will be received, senior superlatives will be recognized, senior slide show will be presented and a reception in the courtyard will follow the ceremony. Graduates wear cap and gown. Dress up for this event as well – no shorts – no jeans.

Graduation & Senior Celebration Tickets

Each senior will be given 10 tickets for graduation and 2 tickets for senior celebration on May 9th & May 10th. Seniors that have not met graduation requirements will not be given tickets. All obligations need to be satisfied for tickets. Tickets will be handed out during lunch in the courtyard. Requests for extra tickets for graduation may be made on

Dress Expectations for Graduation

(Graduates out of Dress Code will not be allowed to participate)

- Ladies- dress or skirt with dress shoes. Ladies are strongly cautioned about wearing high heels – you will be walking from the gym to the stadium, around the track, through the grass and across the stage.
- Men- shirt and tie with dress pants and dress shoes.

Graduation

Honors Sash

For those who qualify to wear an honors sash at graduation, you can purchase a sash after graduation practice on May 16th in the courtyard. Cost \$21.

Honor Graduate Designation – from 2018-19 SDIRC Student Progression Plan

A student may qualify as an honor graduate by receiving no less than eleven credits in courses which have been designated as having rigorous content...These include all Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate, Honors, and Dual Enrollment courses. A student must have an overall GPA of no less than a 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale) and must have received a grade of no less than a "C" in any course specified as an Honor Graduate course.
