GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- 24 (specific) credits
- 2.0 *unweighted* GPA
- Passing test score in Reading and Math
 - Can be through state retakes (FSA, FAST, Alg/Geom EOC, BEST)
 - Can be through ACT, SAT, or CLT **concordant scores**

Concordant score: A score earned on another test that the state recognizes as similar in content and difficulty to a Florida state assessment. The state of Florida accepts these in place of a passing score on FSA or Algebra 1/Geometry EOCs.

UPCOMING TESTING

- State testing dates for tests required for graduation:
 - Next 2 weeks: FAST & FSA re-takes (Writing and Reading), EOC & BEST Algebra 1 or Geometry re-takes
- SAT/ACT tests
 - Sept 16th: at-home CLT
 - Sept 19th: school day CLT
 - Oct 7th: Saturday SAT (sign up online at <http://sat.org>)
 - Oct 11th: school day SAT (free to all seniors who need concordant score)
 - Oct 14th: at-home CLT (sign up online at <http://cltexam.com>)
 - Oct 18th: school day CLT (\$35 sign up with Mrs. Walker)
 - Oct 28th: ACT (sign up online at <http://act.org>)
 - Oct 31st, Nov 1st & 2nd: Nonreportable ACT (free to all seniors who need concordant score)

Preparing

- SAT: Khan Academy <https://www.khanacademy.org/> Students can connect their SAT account with their Khan Academy account. Khan Academy will take their scores and develop a personalized study guide.
- ACT: If you qualify for F&RL, your student receives a study guide found at the top of their ACT dashboard. If not, there are practice tests (timed and untimed) that can be found at the bottom of their ACT dashboard under tests & prep.
- CLT: Once signed up for a test, there are three practice tests that can be found on the bottom right side of the student's dashboard.

Tip: Know your student's login info! You will be able to access scores, help sign up, know upcoming dates, & help them study!

CONCORDANT SCORES

- ELA
 - SAT: 480 on EBRW
 - ACT: Average of 18 between English and Reading subtests
 - CLT: 36 combined score on English and Reading
 - ACT & CLT can "super score" English & Reading
- Math
 - SAT: 420
 - ACT: 16
 - PSAT: 430
 - CLT: 11

CREDIT RECOVERY

- Credit Recovery: Edgenuity

- These are classes your student needs to earn a passing grade in because they previously failed it (core classes) OR need to re-take to improve grade to raise GPA.
- Credit Recovery class: If adequate progress is not made by end of 1st quarter, students will be *removed* from the class and required do all Edgenuity on their own time. We will not permit them to sit in there not working and taking a seat from someone else who needs it.
